They have added a 1,000 ft. lazy river, a 13,000 sq.ft. wave pool, and a large children's play area.

Over 3,000 feet of Uniwall was used on this project. Some of the wall was stacked to accommodate the wave pool. Our movement boxes and overflow boxes were also used to keep the river moving and the surface clean.
