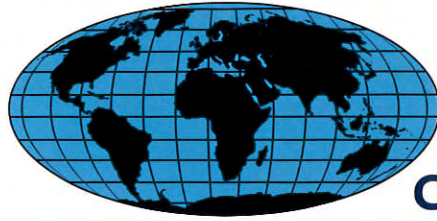

ON THEIR AWARD WINNING POOLS AT THE INTERNATIONAL AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE IN ORLANDO.

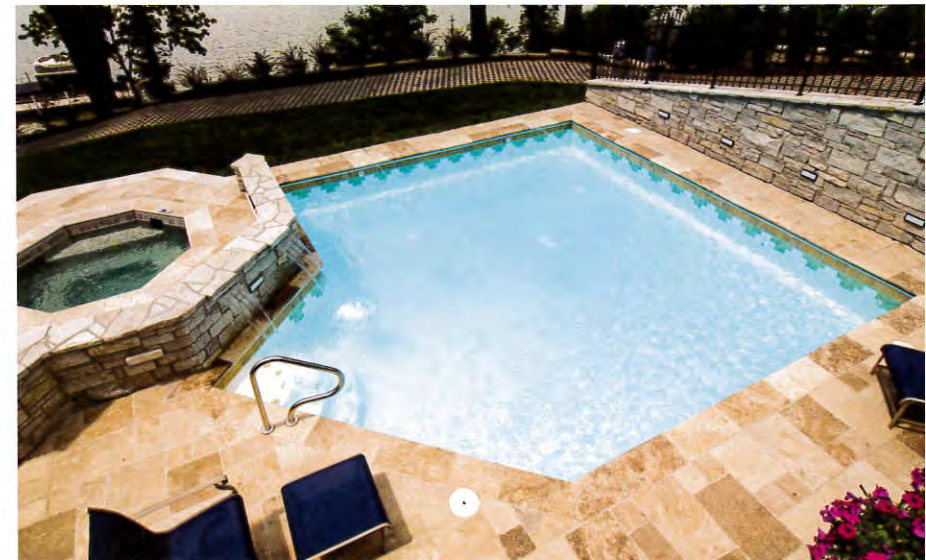


On the cover is the gold medal winner. It was built by John Pischieri, owner of Moonlight Pools in Hinckley, Ohio. This pool has a spectacular view and was constructed on the shores of Lake Erie. The pool was quite a technical feat dealing with the elevation changes. The majority of the pool and balance tank were built completely out of the ground. Uniwall was also used for the balance tank by stacking two walls together. The balance tank is six feet wide and twenty-five feet long. The pool is just over 1,000 sq. ft. It has four water features and uses over one mile of pipe. It requires seven pumps, three filters and three heaters. Congratulations to John who has been building Family Fun pools for over 15 years.

Also, congratulations to Dave Mossing of Mossing Pools. His pool was featured in the last issue. He took home a bronze metal at the show.

## SNO COVE

Sno Mountain is a ski resort in Scranton, Pennsylvania. This summer a decision was made to add a waterpark. This \$9.5 million expansion will include a lazy river, wave pool, waterslides, interactive kiddie area, miniature golf and other attractions. Family Fun was awarded the lazy river, wave pool, splash pools and interactive kiddie pool. Construction began on the lazy river this fall. There were 2,000 linear feet of wall utilized on the lazy river. This project was interrupted by winter and will be completed next spring. The unique circumstances of this park is that much of it will be deliberately buried under the snow as skis glide over the waterpark. As you read, this lazy river is under 4 feet of snow.
